

# HORSE

*Please note: -*

*All exhibitors must bring their horse passports with them to the Show as they may be asked to show them to Trading Standards.*

*Horse Transport must not leave the Lorry Park until after the Grand Parade as per Rule 11.*

*Ridden Section – In the event of a fall of horse and/or rider the competitor should leave the ring immediately on foot.*

*The Judge need not ride all horses forward.*

*Riding hats must comply with the current safety standard and be worn by riders at all times when mounted.*

*Grand Parade Raffle - £100 Prize kindly sponsored by Bowen Son & Watson. All prize winners appearing in the Grand Parade are eligible.*

*Cups can be collected from the secretary's office after the grand parade has finished.*

*Payment of Prize Money – Horse Class Prizes will be sent by cheque within two weeks of the show.*

*Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 –92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.*

*Horses must have been vaccinated within 12 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show.*

## *Foals*

*In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.*

*Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.*

*Please consult your own veterinary practice for further information.*

Your personal data: exhibitor/s you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you. 1. In the case of an animal not registered at the time of entry at the show at which a medal is competed for, application for registration or entry in the Appendix must be made within one month of the date of the show, otherwise the medal will not be awarded.
2. No animal shall be awarded more than one medal in any one year. Medals awarded by the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society are accepted from this rule (i.e. an animal can be awarded one gold, one silver and one bronze in any one season).
3. Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society who have paid their subscriptions for the current year or are life members or who

have submitted their name for membership and paid one annual subscription or Life membership composition.

4. All colts and stallions, 4 years old or over must be in possession of a Society Licence of correctness (or acknowledged alternative) to be eligible for the award of a medal. Half an inch will be allowed in height for shoeing.
